2. **abbreviate** (bir kelimeyi veya bir yazıyı)

kısaltmak = shorten

- The United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund is **abbreviated** as UNICEF.

3. **abduct** bir kişiyi kaçırmak = kidnap

- Richie and Chaim Hatford were **abducted** from their home and found in Mexico City two days later.

4. **abnormal** garip, normalden farklı

- Abnormal** psychology is the branch of psychology that studies unusual patterns of behaviour.

5. **abolish** (bir sistemi veya uygulamayı) resmi olarak sonlandırmak, terketmek

- Mauritania was the last country to **abolish** slavery, with a presidential decree in 1981.

6. **abort** (bir süreci, planı veya aktiviteyi) henüz tamamlanmadan durdurmak = stop

- The commander **aborted** the mission and asked all his soldiers to leave due to security concerns.

7. **abrupt** ani = sudden

- The project came to an **abrupt** halt due to a lack of finances and all workers were sent home till the company gathers enough money to pay them.

8. **absence** (bir yerde) bulunmama, mevcut olmama X presence

- In the **absence** of her mother, the baby cries non-stop till she falls asleep.

9. **absent-minded** unutkan = forgetful

- You need to see the doctor as you are too **absent-minded** to survive in the city. You may forget the way to your house.

10. **absolutely** tamamen

- Priyanka Chopra's red Dior dress for Indian wedding reception is **absolutely** stunning.
- I **absolutely** believe that people, unless coached, never reach their maximum capabilities.

11. **absorb** emmek, içine almak

- Products that are designed and intended to **absorb** echo within a room are soft, light, fluffy products.

12. **abstain (from)** yapmamak, yapmaktan kaçınmak

- I am not saying that I will quit alcohol, I will just **abstain from** it as much I can.

13. **abstract** soyut, gerçek olaylara veya şeylere dayanmayan = theoretical

- Examples of **abstract** terms include love, success, freedom, good, moral, democracy the combination of which basically shapes our lives.
